FLOWER FESTIVAL: DECK THE HALLS

As mentioned at the March Council meeting, the Area is planning to hold a flower festival at the Falkland Islands Memorial Chapel, Pangbourne College on the above dates with staging on Friday 25th November, and takedown at 4pm on Sunday 27th November.

The "Deck the Halls" festival will include traditional and contemporary groups of designs, each based on a Christmas carol or song. The following types of design are envisaged:

- 1. Wreaths, garlands and swags varying sizes
- 2. Trees: Christmas trees, topiary trees. Yattendon Estate may supply Christmas trees
- 3. Standard Oasis tray designs to fit on the balcony ledge
- 4. Angel exhibits (tall and narrow)
- 5. Hanging stars and spheres
- 6. Plaques with Christmas stockings 50cm x 90cm backboards will be provided
- 7. Scenes: Nativity, 3 kings, snow scenes, reindeer and sleigh etc. Does anyone have a reindeer and/or sleigh? If so what size?
- 8. Traditional Christmas at Home scenes, eg tree, dining table, fireplace, presents etc.

This is an exciting festival for the Area, and we really hope you will be able to give it your support. Designs may be done by clubs or individuals. Portable designs could be brought to the Chapel, or delivered beforehand to a committee member, or brought to the November AGM.
