Your visits include:

Winterbourne House & Garden: A unique heritage attraction, an Edwardian house and Botanic Garden nestled in a leafy corner of Birmingham. The house was built as a family home for the Nettleford family in 1904 and is now owned by the University of Birmingham.

Bluebell Arboretum & Nursery: An award-winning, family run, mail order and retail nursery specialising in trees, shrubs, climbers and woody herbaceous plants including a large selection of very rare and unusual varieties. It is a Royal Horticultural Society recommended garden, with nine acre of stunning woodland garden.

Calke Abbey and Gardens (National Trust): Calke Abbey, the Un-stately home. A Grade I listed country house estate located near Ticknall, Derbyshire. The site was an Augustinian priory from the 12th century until its dissolution by Henry VIII. You will be able to visit the beautiful, yet faded walled gardens and explore the orangery, auricula theatre and the kitchen gardens.

Renishaw Hall & Gardens: A Grade I listed country house in Renishaw. It has been home of the Sitwell family for nearly 400 years. The stunning Italianate gardens were laid out in the late 19th Century by Sir George Sitwell 4th Baronet. He was the brilliantly eccentric great-grandfather of the current owner Alexandra Sitwell.

Cascades House & Gardens: Inspired by Japanese and Buddhist philosophy, Cascade Gardens is a celebration of Nature, a perfect place to find peace of mind to relax and reflect. One of Britain's most inspiring Spring Gardens (as listed by the Daily Mail), Cascades is designed around a spectacular 4-acre landscape in old quarry, with a ruined corn mill, canal, cliff and stream. Every season brings new surprises with hellebores, unusual perennial flowers, trees, shrubs and conifers.

Burrows Gardens: A delightful corner of Derbyshire, with a collection of loved and cared for gardens, ideal for a gentle stroll or a journey of discovery into the intricacies of Mother Nature. Whether you are a knowledgeable plants person, a gardener, or just someone who loves beauty, peace and tranquillity of lovely gardens set in 5 acres of beautiful countryside Burrows Garden has something for everyone.

Melbourne Hall Gardens: A Georgian country house with its broad sweep of lawn, avenues and unexpected vistas, it is one of the best known historic gardens in the country and the best surviving 18th century English garden in the manner of Le Notre. That said, you don't have to be a historian or horticulturalist to enjoy the beauty of Melbourne Hall Gardens.
