Holly Berry is a lovely little lady that stands 70cms tall. She wears very stylish clothes and amazing boots. She would look good in any Christmas setting surrounded by Christmas foliage. She is made from cones of card and covered in suitable material. Her boots are made from Actimel pots! (which I will supply) She can be decorated however you like. Just enjoy and have fun!

Items you need to bring:-

- Table covering
- Pencil, ruler and Sharpie Pen
- Gaffer/Duck Tape (any colour)
- scissors, secateurs
- 2 pieces of card-cereal box 21cm x 19cm and stiffer card 30cm x 30cm and 24cm x 24 cm
- full tube of UHU glue
- PVA glue and brush
- Oasis Fix
- 40 pence in 2 pence coinage (for weights)
- Thick, flexible string (at least 8 metres) i.e. ① Jute or very thick wool (I like blanket yarn) to cover her boots.
- A piece of Bleached Mulberry Bark* or any interesting fabric (to make her clothes) 82 cms x 35 cms
- Fur trim for her hat (optional) although I will supply cotton wool.

Items to decorate her clothes and boots:-

- small larch cones, acorn cups, holly leaves, birch stars, artificial berries, small Christmas baubles, ribbons and trims

Raid your Christmas Box...go wild with the decorations you choose!

① Jute string may be purchased from me on the day.

*I will be supplying (At no extra cost to you.)
garden canes, cotton wool, polystyrene head, washed gravel,
Actimel Pots, masking tape, wood chip wall paper*

Glue guns will be set up for you to use on the day.
