“All Around the Town”

Class 1 (Club Class)

(Only open to Clubs affiliated to BB&O Area of NAFAS.)

“Enchanted Forest”

Space allowed – 1.25m square, height unlimited, to be staged inside a marquee on grass (own base permitted) against off-white wall of a marquee.

Exhibit to be viewed and judged from the front.

No water retaining foam may be used.

Up to two people may arrange the entry.

BB&O Area will give each Club who enter £100 towards the cost of their entry.

Class 2

“A River Runs Through It”

(Open only to members of NAFAS)

A Hanging Exhibit

To be hung from a hook against a black material background

Competitor to provide their own hanging loop.

Space allowed 70cm wide, 70cm deep, optional drop length from hook to a maximum of 150cm.

Exhibit must include fresh plant material.

No water retaining foam may be used.

May be brought partially assembled.

Class 3

Imposed Class

(Open only to members of NAFAS)

All materials will be provided – entry fee £35.

The exhibit will be staged on tabling 75cm from the ground, to be viewed and judged from the front. It will be a foam-free exhibit.

Title, materials and further staging details will be given to all competitors inside the NAFAS marquee at 2.15pm on 6th June.

All Competitors must then start to stage their exhibit at 2.30pm, finishing by 4.30pm

Competitors must bring with them their own flower scissors, craft knife and strong secateurs; nothing else can be taken into the staging area.

Storage for bags will be provided, but please keep these to a minimum.

Class 4

“Snapshot of The Savill Gardens”

(Open only to members of BB&O Area of NAFAS)

A Petite Exhibit (to be staged within width 25cms, depth 25cms, height 37.5cms)

To be staged on open tabling covered in black material.

To be viewed and judged from the front.

No water retaining foam may be used.

May be brought ready-assembled.

Class 5

“Anniversary Gift”

(Open only to members of BB&O Area of NAFAS)

A craft class to be viewed all round. May be brought ready-assembled.

To be staged on open tabling 75cm from the ground covered in black material.

Space allowed 30cm square, height optional.

Floral foam may not be used in this exhibit.

This will be a People’s Choice class where the winning exhibits will be those receiving the most votes from the general public visiting the show.

AWARDS

The winner of Class 1 will receive the Flower Arranger Award

Prize Money will be awarded for Classes 2, 3, 4 and 5 as follows: 1st £40, 2nd £30, 3rd £20.

Trophies will be awarded to winners of each class plus a Trophy for the Best Exhibit in the Show (excluding Class 5)

RULES

1. Entries to be made on the Booking Form which is available via the What's On section of the BB&O Area Website: bbandoflowers.org.uk
2. Places in each class will be allocated on receipt of completed forms until the class is full. Those entering the class who have been successful in securing a place will be notified, at which point the entry fee is payable.
3. Closing date for entries is Friday 23rd May
4. The entry fee for classes 2, 4 and 5 is £5; for class 3 it is £35; there is no entry fee for Class 1
5. Classes 1, 4 and 5 are only open to members of Berks Bucks and Oxon (BB&O) Area of NAFAS. Classes 2 and 3 are open to members of NAFAS from any Area.
6. Competitors should inform the Show Committee as soon as possible if unable to exhibit as planned.
7. Staging may take place from 10.00 am to 5pm on Friday 6th June (with the exception of Class 3 which has specific times for arrival and completion)
8. Exhibits can be collected between 5.00pm and 7.00pm on 7th June.
9. Prize-giving will take place at 4.00pm on 7th June
10. All competitors will receive a Complimentary Ticket to enter the Show on 7th June which will be distributed on arrival for staging.
11. Judging will be in accordance with NAFAS Rules as set out in the NAFAS Competitions Manual Fourth Edition 2023. The Judge's decisions are final.
12. The use of any type of floral foam is not permitted in any exhibit
13. The positions occupied by all exhibits will be decided by the Show Committee
14. All entries are to be original work and not exhibited before in their entirety
15. Aerosol sprays of any description must not be used in the competition marquee and competitors are asked to cover the ground outside before undertaking any spraying.
