### Royal Windsor Flower Show

Saturday 6 June 2026



The York Club, Windsor Great Park, [SL4 2BS](#) (enter via Ranger's Gate off the A332 and follow signs)

#### **CLASS 1: DANCING THE NIGHT AWAY** (Club Class)

- Club Class (BB&O Clubs only) – may be staged by up to 2 people. BB&O Area will give each Club £100 towards the cost of their entry on completion of staging
- Space allowed: 125cm square, height unlimited. Staged inside a marquee on grass (own base permitted)
- Title to be included
- To be viewed and judged all round

#### **CLASS 2: CIRQUE DU SOLEIL** (Hanging Exhibit)

- Hanging exhibit staged against a black background
- To be hung from a pole with hook 200cm from the ground. Competitor to provide own hanging loop.
- Space allowed: width 70cm, depth 70cm, drop from pole up to 150cm
- To be viewed and judged from the front
- May be brought partially assembled, but must include fresh plant material

#### **CLASS 3: ROCK AROUND THE CLOCK** (Table top exhibit)

- An exhibit staged on open tabling 75cm from the ground, covered in green drape, against side of the marquee
- Space allowed: width 90cm, depth 69cm, height optional
- To be viewed and judged from the front

#### **CLASS 4: CAN CAN** (Craft Class)

- A craft exhibit which may include fresh plant material
- Exhibit to include a decorated can or cans
- Staged on open tabling 75cm from the ground, covered in green drape, against side of the marquee
- Space allowed: width 30cm, depth 30cm, height optional
- To be viewed and judged from the front

#### **CLASS 5: LET'S TWIST AGAIN** (Imposed class)

- An exhibit staged on open tabling 75cm from the ground, covered in green drape, against side of the marquee
- Space allowed: width 60cm, depth 60cm, height optional
- To be viewed and judged from the front
- All materials provided – entry fee £35.
- All competitors to assemble inside the marquee at 2.15pm on Friday 5th June. All Competitors must start staging at 2.30pm, finishing by 4.30pm
- Competitors must bring their own flower scissors, craft knife, pliers, wire cutters and strong secateurs. Nothing else to be taken into the staging area.
- Storage for bags will be provided, but please keep to a minimum.

## Competition Rules

1. Entries to be made via the Entry Form accessible via the BB&O Area Website at [Area Events](#) or scan the QR code at the bottom of this schedule.
2. Places in each class will be allocated on a first come first served basis on receipt of completed form and entrance fee until the class is full.
3. Closing date for entries is Friday 22nd May.
4. Entry fees:
  - No entry fee for Class 1 – Clubs will receive £100 towards the cost of staging the exhibit
  - £5 for classes 2-4
  - £35 for class 5 which includes provision of all materials
5. Classes open as follows:
  - Class 1 – Clubs in the BB&O Area. May be staged by up to 2 people
  - All other classes open to anyone
6. Awards:
  - Class 1 – Winning club will receive a one year subscription to the Flower Arranger Magazine
  - All other classes: 1<sup>st</sup> prize - £30; 2<sup>nd</sup> prize - £20; 3<sup>rd</sup> prize - £10
7. No water retaining foam may be used
8. Measurements in all classes are approximate. Nothing to be attached to the backgrounds.
9. The positions occupied by all exhibits will be decided by the Show Committee.
10. All entries are to be original work and not exhibited before in their entirety.
11. Exhibits will be judged in accordance with the NAFAS Competitions Manual, Fourth Edition (2023), and NAFAS supplement [Plant-Material-in-all-its-forms-Sept-2018.pdf](#)
12. The judge's decisions are final.
13. Aerosol sprays of any description must not be used in the competition marquee and competitors are asked to cover the ground outside before undertaking any spraying.
14. The BB&O Area and Royal Windsor Flower Show Organisation regret they cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to exhibits or personal property.
15. Free passes to the Royal Windsor Flower Show will be given to exhibitors on completion of staging.
